## **MEQUON COMMUNITY FOUNDATION RAISING FUNDS FOR NEW K-9 OFFICER**

The Mequon Community Foundation raises funds annually for the Mequon Police Department and their K-9 program through generous donations from individuals and groups.

MPD's current K-9 officer is named Iron. Along with his handler, Sgt. Jake Schiller, Officer Iron works unflaggingly on behalf of the 23,000 residents of Mequon. Officer Iron provides a level of tracking, searching, compliance and relationship-building that cannot be duplicated by a human being. In addition, the team is often called upon to assist the Ozaukee County Sheriff or other local communities.


At 7 years old and 5 years of service, Officer Iron is nearing the end of his service career and the time has come to train and ready a new dog to take his place when he retires. An anonymous Mequon resident offered a challenge grant of \$50,000 if the MPD and MCF could raise another \$50,000 - which we have done! To date, we have raised \$130,000 towards the \$150,000 goal to

acquire, equip, train and maintain a acquire, equip, train and maintain a second K9 officer and handler during a **GOAL!** two-year transition period until Officer Iron's retirement.

The K9 program has proven to be an integral part of ensuring a low crime rate in Mequon - and one of the lowest in Wisconsin. The impact of the K9 program goes beyond law enforcement requirements toward building community relations. Sgt. Schiller and Officer Iron participated in 15 school events and made 11 public appearances last year in an effort to build rapport between the community and the police force. It is especially important for children to learn that the police officer is approachable and to see Sgt. Schiller and Officer Iron in non-crisis situations.
